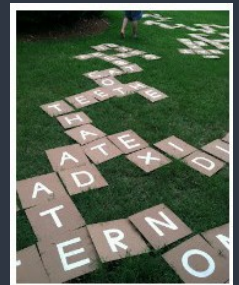
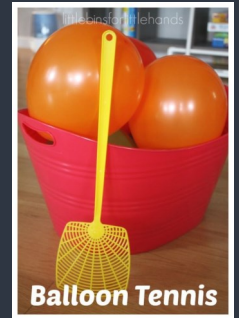

Activities: Looking for New & Fun

As Campground Owners, the search for new, fun, and simple activities is ongoing. The activities have to be easy to pull together, intriguing for campers, and a quick pickup. Below is a few items that the WACO staff has come across and enjoyed.

- **Balloon Tennis:** With the use of two items, balloons and a fly swatter, this yard game can make sure a simple set-up! The idea is to have either two individual players or two teams with each participant having a fly swatter. The goal is to pass the balloon back and forth over a line or net without it touching the ground.
- **Giant Scrabble:** While the first preparation of Giant Scrabble might take some time, it is totally worth it to keep your campers busy and enjoying their time. To make Giant Scrabble, you will need either white paint or a large bright marker and 1ft x 1ft square cardboard or pre-cut corkboard squares (available at Walmart, Joann Fabrics, Hobby Lobby, etc.). Next, paint or write each letter of the alphabet on your designated 1ft x 1ft surface. It is recommended to do 3 copies of the alphabet as well as extra for the vowels giving your campers more options for words. Print off a copy of the instructions on Hasbro.com for campers to use incase.
- **Inflatable Ring Toss:** Often used as a teambuilding experience or minute-to-win-it game, the Inflatable Ring Toss can include all ages in either a race to win or a competition of how many rings. With the use of several circle pool tubes, designate someone to be the stand, by standing straight up hands in the air, trying to have all the rings land on his or her body. Again, it is your choice whether to make it a race between teams or a competition of how many tubes stacked.
- **Frisbee Tic-Tac-Toe:** Take a old flat sheet and lay it flat on the ground. Use blue painters tape to split the sheet up into thirds (width way) and again into thirds (height way). This should leave you with 9 equal-sized rectangles across your flat sheet. Take ten Frisbees . Paint/write an "X" on five of the Frisbees and an "O" on the other five. Once dried, your giant Tic-Tac-Toe board is ready to be used!
- **Giant Memory:** Purchase a pack of 20 poster boards. Depending on your artist abilities, draw or print & tape an image onto two boards. Continue drawing or taping a different image every two boards. When the boards are filled, create five rows of four using the boards. Make sure the boards are upside down and the images are not visible for campers. From there, the campers take turns flipping boards trying to find the match.
- **Giant Connect Four:** Lay a flat sheet or shower curtain on the ground. By using a plastic circle plate, trace the plate and draw six rows of seven equal-distance apart. In the middle of each circle on the cloth, glue or tape a piece of Velcro. Purchase 20 red plates and 20 blue plates. Attach the opposite piece of Velcro to the back of the plates. Let the game begin! The plates are now able to stick to the cloth in position for the game.

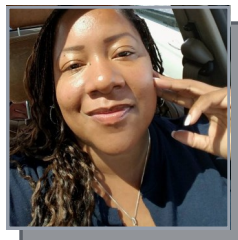

Instagram Tips from PartyMachines.com

Back again with some more Instagram tips. I'll skip the fluffy introduction, let's get into it.

1. Post every single day at least one time but not more than 2 or 3 times and spread your posts out. Don't post all at once. Pick a few times throughout the day and post!
2. Something is better than nothing. Don't say you don't have content. Create it and share it. You carry your smartphone around. Take photos of things that interest you and relate to your products. Do you make deliveries? Take photos of your vehicle. Take photos of your products. ASK before taking photos of your customers. Take 8-second videos (or longer) of your customers telling you how great you are.
3. Think bigger and broader. This means that you don't rent inflatables or tables and chairs. You sell F-U-N fun. Show that F-U-N in your photos. Think before you take your photos. You aren't posting a photo of a bounce house. You're posting photos of the fun that I can have in the bounce house. It's a process. Social media today is about telling a story with your videos/pictures. Think about it. Sleep on it.

That's it for today. Now.... go out and take tons of photos and short videos. You always want to have too many so when you're uninspired or on vacation, you don't run out of content. Let me know how I can help!
