MOBILE SEWER SERVICE: Regular scheduled pump out days are Mondays and Thursdays. If you need pumping out on a non-scheduled day (subject to availability) there is a \$20 fee. WISCONSIN STATE LAW <u>PROHIBITS ANY GROUND DUMPING OF GREY OR</u> BLACK WATER.

WiFi: Wireless internet is throughout most of the campground and does not need a password. NO MOVIE OR TV STREAMING.

MAIL: Do NOT fill out a change of address form through USPS unless if you have an end date as a temporary address change. You may have mail forwarded here. US Mail, UPS, and FedEx is usually here by 4:00pm. There is an outgoing mailbox at the front desk.

LAUNDRY: Open 24 hours. Located behind the office, next to the pool. Change machine in office.

SHOWERS: Located in the main building complex and are coin operated to conserve water. Open 24 hours.

SPEED LIMIT: Strictly enforced 5 MPH throughout the campground.

PARKING: Please keep all vehicles on the gravel pad. Limited to one vehicle per site; additional parking available by the office.

GUESTS: Only registered campers and guests are allowed in the campground. Day visitors must register at the office, entitling them to all campground facilities. Charges are \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for children. Seasonal/Monthly Sites, immediate family members are exempt from visitor fee but must register in the office. Passes are enforced: violators will be charged double the fee. All guests are required to leave the grounds by 10:00pm.

QUIET HOURS: Campers must be quiet 10:30pm-7:30am. Respect your neighbor and keep noise to a minimum.

PETS: Well behaved and leashed pets are welcome. Owners are responsible for picking up after them and any damages caused by them. No pets allowed in any of the buildings or swimming pool area.

INCLIMATE WEATHER: You are in Brown County in the town of Wrightstown. If a severe weather warning is issued, please go to the Rec Hall or main bathrooms for shelter.
