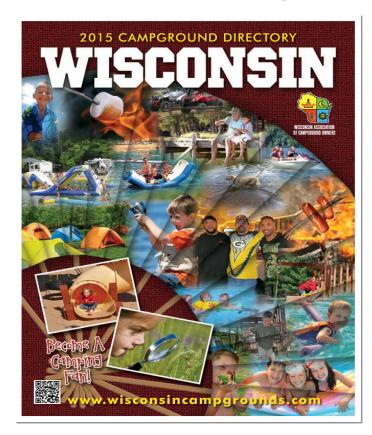

I purchased this product in October. It was supposed to be a month to month. HOWEVER they charged the full amount.

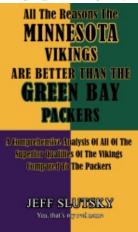

On Thursday, he will be speaking on Advertising On A Shoestring and Marketing Without Money.

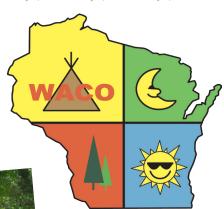






HOLIDAY HAPPENINGS
