Coverage Maps



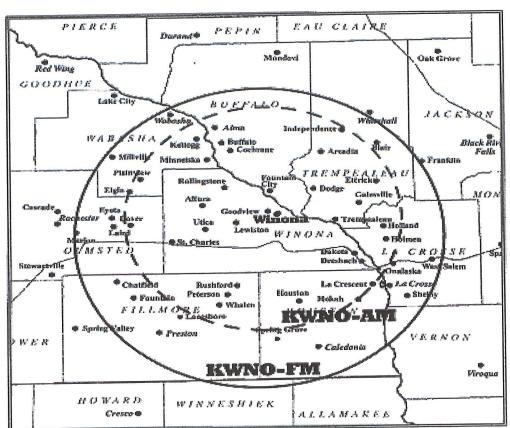

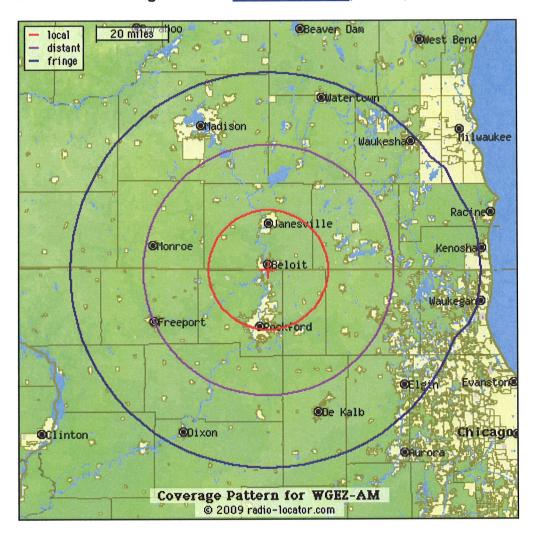

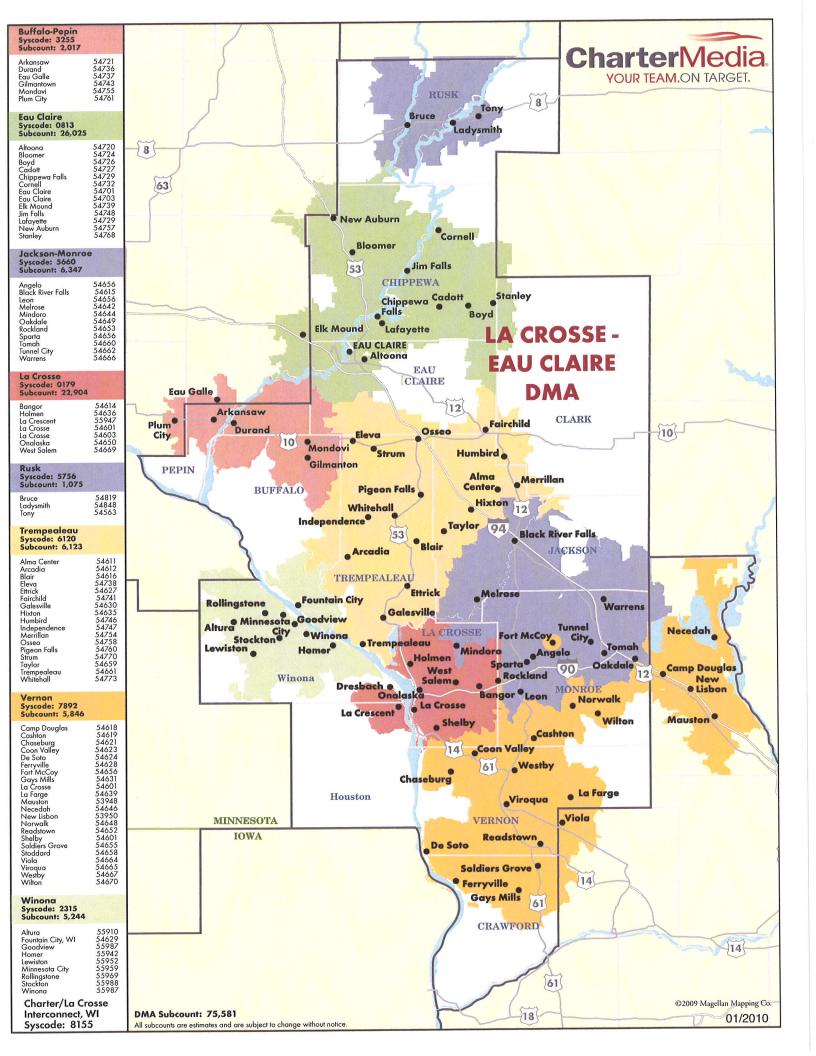

Predicted coverage area for WGEZ 1490 AM, Beloit, WI



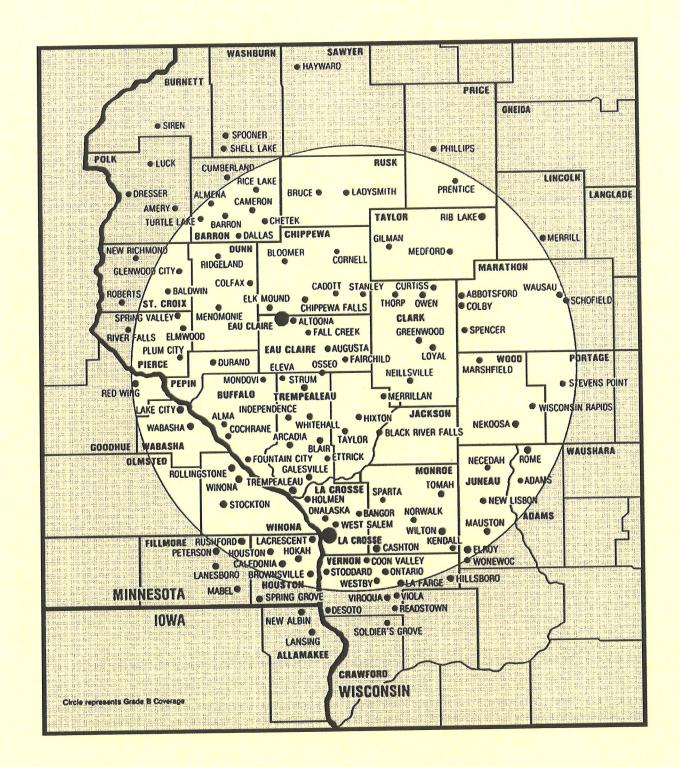
