

NOTICE CONCERNING SERVICE AND COMFORT ANIMALS

SERVICE ANIMALS

We welcome service animals assisting persons with disabilities. Service animals are limited to animals individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the disabled. Service animals must be harnessed, leashed or tethered. We may ask whether the dog is a service dog required by a disability, and, what work or task the dog has been trained to perform. Service animals are allowed in any premises where guests are welcome, but must be under the immediate control of the owner at all times.

COMFORT ANIMALS

We do not allow guests to bring animals, including dogs, as emotional support or comfort animals. The Americans with Disabilities Act does not require business to allow support or comfort animals. This is true even if the support or comfort animals are “registered,” wear a vest or have a doctor’s note.¹
