Whiskey barrel planters, old water troughs, old farm feeders, buckets, old cowboy boots with succulents.

Establish who will be in charge of the watering and how often, where is the nearest watersite? Make it convenient to water or it may not happen.

What to use, options include shredded barks, pine needles, pine bark, wood chips, leaf mulch
