The CPO seal of approval is assurance to commercially owned pool and spas that their facility and their swimmers are under the supervision of trained professionals. CPO certification courses are designed to provide individuals with the knowledge, techniques, and skills of pool and spa operations. Including pool and spa chemistry, testing, treatment, filtration, maintenance, automatic feeding equipment, government requirements and more. The CPO certification program requires participation in either a two-day class taught by a certified instructor or the blended format that combines an online Pool Operator Primer Course and a one-day Pool Operator Fusion Course. The CPO certification program requires an open book exam and is valid for five years. Successful completion of the certification program provides eligibility for CEU credits and is good for 5 years.
